



General Programme Overview

Q1. What is the Infinity Series?

SGInnovate's Infinity (∞) Series is a **Deep Tech Immersion Programme** that places motivated and talented students in vital roles within your technical team while curating a meaningful development journey for them, in general tech functions such as Software Development, Data Engineering, Data Analytics, UI / UX design, etc.

Q2. What is the difference between Infinity Series and the Summation Programme?

The Summation Programme offers **apprenticeships** for full-time students and fresh graduates to work on Deep Tech projects in areas such as **Artificial Intelligence, Quantum Computing, Robotics**, etc.

In comparison, the Infinity Series offers **internships** for full-time students to take on general tech roles in Deep Tech startups, in areas such as **Software Development, Data Engineering, Data Analytics, UI / UX design**, etc.

Q3. How will the Infinity Series help organisations and students?

By participating in the Infinity Series, Deep Tech startups or organisations with Deep Tech projects can gain motivated talent with diverse competencies that elevate their teams, while benefitting from SGInnovate's co-funding support.

Conversely, the Infinity Series provides students with exposure to Deep Tech projects and opportunities to develop their technical capabilities which would boost their employability when they graduate. The programme provides new opportunities for organisations and talent to explore a deeper long-term working relationship in the future as well.

In addition, students will also benefit from:

- Dedicated mentorship from a tech lead
- Training opportunities in their relevant scope of work
- Networking and learning opportunities via SGInnovate's Deep Tech events



Before Application

Q4. Who is eligible for the Infinity Series?

Singapore Citizens / Permanent Residents	Foreigners
Current Polytechnic, Undergraduate, Master's or PhD student from Institutes of Higher Learning (IHL)	Current Polytechnic, Undergraduate, Master's or PhD student from Institutes of Higher Learning (IHL) in Singapore*

*If the applicant is holding a Student Pass in Singapore, he/she is only allowed to work he/she meets specific requirements. Click [here](#) to find out more.

The applicant must be able to showcase relevant skills and knowledge for the project that he/she applies for, e.g.:

- Academic courses in IHLs
- Online courses (e.g. Coursera, Udemy)
- Projects (e.g. Github, Stackoverflow)
- Working experience (e.g. internships, part-time, freelance)
- Awards and competitions (e.g. Hackathons, Datathons)

Q5. Do all organisations offer the same projects and roles?

No. Each organisation will provide the scope and specify the duration unique to the roles and projects offered.

Q6. What types of internship are eligible for the Infinity Series?

The Infinity Series is only open for general tech roles in areas such as Software Development, Data Engineering, Data Analytics and UI / UX design etc., within cutting-edge Deep Tech projects. Non-tech roles such as sales, marketing and product management do not qualify for the programme. Infinity Series – FAQ for Students

Q7. Can I use the Infinity Series as a credit-bearing internship?

Applicants will need to check with their schools on such arrangements, SGInnovate does not determine this.

Q8. What is the Infinity Series duration?

The duration of the programme varies based on the project requirements and the intern's availability. If interns wish to extend the attachment period, they will need to arrange with the organisation separately.

Full-Time Students
3 – 6 months with a required minimum commitment of three (3) months full-time

Q9. What is the stipend amount that I will be receiving?

The total package amount varies on the applicant's education level:

Education Level	Monthly Total (SGD)
Polytechnic / Undergraduate	\$1,500
Master's student	\$2,000
PhD Student	\$3,000

Q10. When is the application deadline?

Please submit your completed application form by the following deadlines. No submissions will be accepted after the stipulated deadlines. Applications will be processed every two (2) weeks on a rolling basis. Interested candidates are encouraged to apply as job vacancies and projects will be closed once a match is found.

Q11. Can I amend my application after I have submitted?

The system allows an applicant to edit his/her submission. However, only the last application submitted before the deadline will be considered.

Selection Process

Q12. How will I be matched to the internship role/organisation?

Applications will be evaluated against the respective criteria of each role the applicants have identified in their preference selections.

Q13. What are the technical skills required for this internship programme?

Programming related roles/projects will typically require proficiency in at least one programming language. Ability to showcase relevant knowledge and/or experience related to the role/project is more critical. Please refer to this [link](#) see the specific eligibility criteria for the respective roles/projects.

Q14. What is the shortlisting process?

There are two stages of the shortlisting phase:



Stage 1: Technical assessments

There will be **several assessments** that applicants will take based on the roles they are shortlisted for.

Stage 2: Interviews

Shortlisted applicants who successfully pass the technical assessments will be invited to attend the interview sessions with organisations.

Q15. How and when will I know the outcome of my application?

Applicants will be informed of their application status via email. Shortlisted applicants will receive additional instructions.



Post Selection

Q16. What will happen after I am selected?

Selected applicants will sign a contract with SGInnovate and the organisation before starting the internship.

Q17. When and how will I be receiving my stipend?

The intern's monthly stipend will be paid out along with the organisation's monthly payroll.

Q18. I am a Singaporean/Permanent Resident, will I be paid CPF?

CPF is typically payable for non-credit bearing internships. The interns' universities may offer exemptions to CPF contribution. Interns will need to contact their administrative offices for more details.

Q19. What will happen upon the completion of the Infinity Series?

We will award interns with a certificate of participation. Any working agreement (for example, part-time work) beyond the stipulated duration will be arranged directly between the intern and the organisation. SGInnovate will not be involved.
